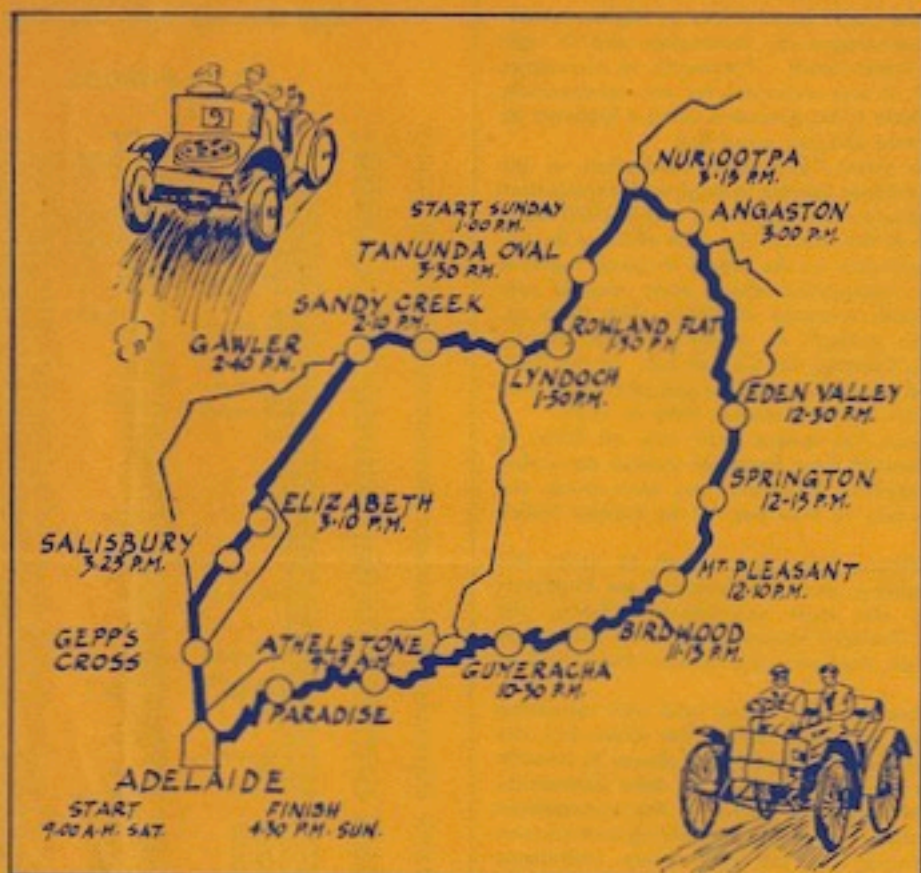


# GOLDEN FLEECE VETERAN CAR RALLY

VETERAN CARS

In 1896 the "Light Locomotives on Highways Act" officially acknowledged the automobile and its right to travel on British roads. Previously, in accordance with the law, it was necessary for any mechanically propelled vehicle to be proceeded along a highway by a person on foot carrying a red flag.

This same year, 1896, saw celebration in the nature of the famous London to Brighton Emancipation run. This became an annual event, and in 1930 led to the formation of the Veteran Car Club of Great Britain.

The second club in the world to band together to exchange information about early models was formed in South Australia in 1934. This lives on, growing from strength to strength as the Veteran Section of the Sporting Car Club of S.A. In this Rally this week-end are both personnel and cars which took part in the first South Australian Rally in 1934.

This interest has spread until now all States in the Commonwealth have bands of veteran car enthusiasts. Twenty-four interstate cars have made the journey especially to take part in the Barossa Valley event.

Golden Fleece have done much to assist this growth. Realising that such vehicles are important milestones in the huge automotive industry, the Company has fostered interest in them by sponsoring rallies in South Australia, the Eastern States and in Tasmania.

As the result of the great and still increasing public interest in these rallies, the Club and the sponsors have made it possible for charity to benefit. This year, as frequently before, St. John Ambulance Brigade is the nominated charity in the metropolitan area, with country ambulances benefiting in the towns en route. During the last eight years, ambulance services in this State have been improved until they compare favourably with any part of the Commonwealth. Many of these improvements are the result of the generous support of the public on occasions such as this.
