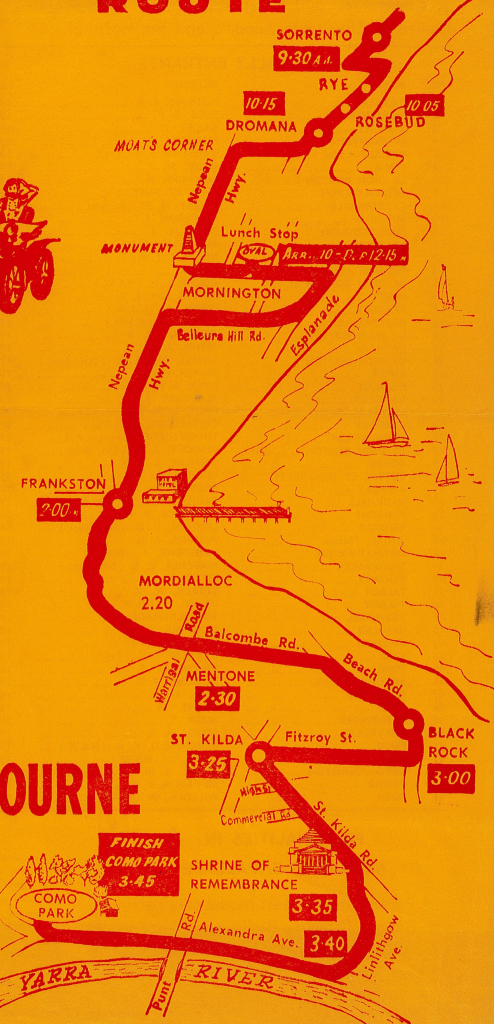

PERSONALITIES IN MOTING CAVALCADE

A Parade of the latest model cars carrying Beauty Queens, Radio — T.V. Personalities will proceed the Procession of Veteran Cars from Black Rock to Como Park on Sunday.

The Golden Fleece organisation has been closely associated with the development of Veteran Car motoring throughout the Commonwealth since 1955. Each year the Company sponsors the major Veteran Car Rally in the various States.

The increasing number of cars, none of them built later than 1916, which compete annually in the Golden Fleece Veteran Car Rallies throughout the country, is a tribute to the men and women who devote hours of dedicated attention to the cars' restoration and preservation.

The Golden Fleece Veteran Car Rallies are not speed trials, but competitions, determined on a points system, which do not hasten the end of the useful lives of the vehicles.

GOLDEN FLEECE AND VETERAN MOTORING

This year's event, a National Rally with Victoria playing host, brings together the largest and most colorful display of Veteran Cars in Australia.

The picturesque Melbourne to Sorrento course has been the route of previous veteran rallies and has proved extremely popular with the public and participants alike.

Since 1934, when the first Veteran Car Club was established in Adelaide, clubs have been formed in all States. The motto of the Victorian Club, *Demencia Prodes* (the translation of which is — "Madness Helps") aptly indicates the magnitude of some of the problems of restoration which veteran enthusiasts undertake and also their ability to have a smile at themselves.

MARCHING GIRLS' DISPLAY

A massed display by teams from the Victorian Marching Girls' Association will be presented to the public at Como Park, on Sunday, 13th November at 3 p.m. prior to the arrival of the veteran cars.
